OBJECTION TO
PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

Let this Honorable Court be advised that Darron Brewer, class member, objects to the proposed settlement in the above-captioned matter. He states the following in support thereof:

1. I was housed as a pre-trial detainee in the Cook County Jail from October 30, 2009 to September 24, 2013.
2. During that time period I was prescribed several prescription medications for serious health needs but was not provided with appropriate medication within 24 hours thereafter.
3. Therefore I am a class member and entitled to object.
4. I do not believe the computing system for each class member's award appropriately compensates class members for their alleged injury.
5. The system does not take into account the severity of the health need, the regular availability of the medication, the type of medication or the length of time each class member went without the prescribed medication.

6. Furthermore, the compensation received by the original plaintiff, 11 additional named Plaintiffs and 19 exemplar class members is unjustifiably greater than the remaining class members.
7. It seems that simply filing grievances and possibly complaints (sec. 1983) and/or appearing at a deposition~~s~~ has entitled them to significantly more compensation than the remainder of the class.
8. Lastly, the Defendants have expressly denied any wrongdoing or violation of any individual's constitutional rights, thus there has been no adjudication of the merits of the complaints of the named Plaintiffs and exemplar class members. Hence we are all in the same boat, so-to-speak, and for that reason all awards should be similar.

Wherefore, Darron Brewer, class member, prays that this Honorable Court note his objection and reject the proposed Settlement agreement.
