WRITTEN OBJECTIONS TO CLASS
ACTION SETTLEMENT

NOW COMES CLASS PLAINTIFF ERIC E. BERNARD,
PRO SE, MOVING THIS COURT TO CONSIDER THIS OBJECTION
AND GRANT HIM THE APPROPRIATE RELIEF AND STATES AS
FOLLOWS:

1.) BETWEEN THE YEARS OF 2007 THROUGH 2010,
PLAINTIFF HAS ENTERED THE COOK COUNTY JAIL AT LEAST
SEVEN DIFFERANT OCCASSIONS

2.) PLAINTIFF SUFFERS FROM SERIOUS MENTAL ILLNESSES WHICH REQUIRE HEAVY PSYCHO MEDICATIONS TO MAINTAIN STABILITY.

3.) PLAINTIFF HAS A RARE BRAIN DIS THAT PROVOKES STROKES AND SEIZURES AND HAS TO TAKE MEDICATIONS SO HIS CONDITION DOES NOT WORSEN.

4.) PLAINTIFF HAS SUFFERED FROM HIS ILLNESSES AND HAS BEEN TAKING MEDICATIONS SINCE A CHILD.

5.) DURING THE (AT LEAST) SEVEN TIMES THAT PLAINTIFF ENTERED THE COOK COUNTY JAIL, HE WAS TAKING SERIOUS MEDICATIONS FOR MEDICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH REASONS.

6.) DEFENDANTS DELAYED OR DENIED THE PLAINTIFF TO HIS MEDICATION FOR DAYS OR MONTHS.

7.) DEFENDANTS WORSEN THE PLAINTIFF MEDICAL HEALTH AND MENTAL HEALTH CONDITION BY DENYING HIM MEDICATION FOR MORE THAN TWENTY FOUR HOURS.

8.) PLAINTIFF RECEIVED NOTICE OF THE SETTLEMENT HEARING AND RECEIVED A FORM TO FILL OUT TO RECEIVE \$200 OF SETTLEMENT AS APPROVED BY THE COURT.

9.) PLAINTIFF OBJECTS TO THE AMOUNT THAT HE IS BEING OFFERED TO HIM. BECAUSE ON AT LEAST SEVEN DIFFERENT TIMES WHEN PLAINTIFF ENTERED COOK COUNTY JAIL THAT THE DEFENDANTS DENIED HIM HIS MEDICATIONS.

10.) PLAINTIFF'S ONLY OBJECTION, IS THAT HE IS ENTITLED TO AT LEAST \$1,400 FOR THE SEVEN TIMES THAT THE DEFENDANTS DELAYED OR DENIED HIM HIS MEDICATION FOR MORE THAN TWENTY FOUR HOURS EACH SEVEN TIMES THAT HE ENTERED THE COOK COUNTY JAIL FROM THE YEAR 2007 TILL 2010.

11.) TO SUPPORT PLAINTIFF'S REQUESTED RELIEF OF \$1,400 HE REQUESTS TO APPEAR AT THE HEARING AND PRODUCE EVIDENCE THROUGH WITNESSES AND MEDICAL RECORDS TO PROVE THAT HE HAS BEEN TAKING SERIOUS MEDICATION SINCE A CHILD AND THAT THE DEFENDANTS ON SEVEN DIFFERENT ENTRIES AT THE COOK COUNTY JAIL HE WAS DELAYED OR DENIED SERIOUS MEDICATIONS FOR DAYS AND MONTHS WHICH RESULTED IN SERIOUS MEDICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH DISABILITIES AND NEAR FATAL EPISODES.

Relief Requested

① PLAINTIFF REQUEST THAT HE APPEAR BEFORE THE COURT, TO BE ALLOWED TO SECURE EVIDENCE AND WITNESSES IN SUPPORT OF THIS ISSUE/MOTION/PETITION.

② FOR PLAINTIFF TO RECEIVE \$1,400 (FOR THE SEVEN TIMES HE ENTERED THE COOK COUNTY JAIL AND DIDN'T GET HIS MEDICE WITHIN TWENTY FOUR HOURS.

③ THAT IF THE COURT AND ALL ~~ADVER~~ ATTORNEYS AGREE TO REWARD PLAINTIFF WITH \$1,400, THE PLAINTIFF WILL WAIVE THE WRITTEN OBJECTION AND ACCEPT THE \$1,400.

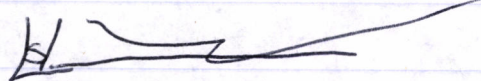
