**PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO SET MOTION ECF No. 118 FOR
TELEPHONIC HEARING AND VACATE BRIEFING SCHEDULE**

Plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court hold a prompt telephone hearing and vacate the briefing schedule on plaintiff's pending Motion to Compel Payment of Settlement Without Face-To-Face Contact, ECF No. 118. The Court can resolve this dispute in a short telephonic hearing without any briefing.

As explained in the pending motion, the City of Chicago has written a check to pay the settlement in this case. The City, however, refuses to convey the check to plaintiff's counsel other than through a face-to-face meeting unless counsel signs a broad and unreasonable waiver of liability. This very narrow dispute is preventing plaintiff from receiving the settlement for which she bargained.

Defendants do not oppose a telephonic hearing, but ask that they be granted a week to file a written response to plaintiff's modest request to mail the already written check.

Plaintiff submits that an immediate and brief telephone hearing would resolve this dispute about sending a check by mail.
