We, the Service Desk, received notification this morning from Chief Sbarboro (District 2 Court House) that Phase II of prisoner property is now in effect, **effective immediately**. The amount of property each prisoner will be allowed to take with them to court has been drastically reduced. The only items now being accepted are listed below:

- US currency
- US government issued identification
- Plain wedding band (no engraving or stones)
- Keys
- Outer garment
- Prescription medication
- Prescription eyeglasses
- Legal documents (soft cover only)
- Shoelaces
- Bible or Koran (soft cover only)
