**PLAINTIFFS' RESPONSE TO
MOTION TO DECERTIFY (ECF No. 217)**

The Court should deny defendants' motion to decertify. Plaintiffs show below that the Court should reject defendants' argument that some class members were not harmed by the challenged policy. But even if the Court accepts the argument, the proper remedy is to amend the class definition.

The Court should also reject defendants' request to change the closing date of the subclasses from October 7, 2019 (when defendants abandoned the express policy at issue) to an unspecified date in July of 2017.¹ (ECF No. 217.) Instead, plaintiffs suggest that the Court modify the class definition as explained below at 12.

¹ Defendant Cook County filed the motion to decertify; defendant Sheriff has moved to joined the motion. (ECF No. 220.) Plaintiffs refer to the request to decertify as "defendants' motion."

1. The motion to decertify is based on an erroneous legal theory

The motion to decertify asks the Court to conclude that any person who was tapered at the Jail and then transferred to the penitentiary or another county jail was not harmed by the tapering policy: Defendants assert that persons who are tapered at the Jail do not suffer any injury if, after having experienced the pain and suffering of tapering, they leave the Jail to serve a sentence in an institution that does not provide methadone maintenance. (ECF No. 218 at 5-6.) The Court should reject this argument, which is about damages, rather than about the requirements of Rule 23.

a. Defendants' argument is about damages

Defendants advanced the same argument when they addressed the predominance requirement in their opposition to class certification:

Without the tapering policy, these patients would have had to go “cold turkey” and suffer the withdrawal symptoms without the benefit of tapering ... Withdrawal symptoms for these individuals can be avoided through the tapering policy.

(ECF No. 157 at 15.) The Court concluded that this argument was potentially relevant to damages, but not to maintainability as a class action:

The bottom line is that getting the common liability answer across the class in one fell swoop is much more important than the separate damages questions.

(ECF No. 178 at 17.) Defendants do not offer any reason for the Court to revisit its prior ruling, which relied on the well-settled rule that variability

in damages among class members is not a bar to class certification when there is commonality about the challenged conduct. (*Id.* at 9) (citing *In re IKO Roofing Shingle Products Liability Litigation*, 757 F.3d 599, 601-03 (7th Cir. 2014).) As the Supreme Court made plain in *Tyson Foods, Inc. v. Bouaphakeo*, 577 U.S. 442 (2016), “[w]hen one or more of the central issues in the action are common to the class and can be said to predominate, the action may be considered proper under Rule 23(b)(3) even though other important matters will have to be tried separately, such as damages or some affirmative defenses peculiar to some individual class members.” *Id.* at 453-54.

b. Defendants’ argument is contrary to principles of tort law

Defendants are unable to reconcile their argument with the “background of tort liability that makes a man responsible for the natural consequences of his actions.” *Monroe v. Pape*, 365 U.S. 167, 187 (1961). Under defendants’ theory, any class member who served a single day in the Illinois Department of Corrections “benefited” from the Jail’s tapering policy and therefore lost standing to seek damages. (ECF No. 218 at 2, 5-6.) Defendants fail to support this theory with citation to any principle of tort law that relieves a tortfeasor of liability because another actor reduces the extent of harm after the tort is committed.

In any event, defendants are unable to explain how confinement in the penitentiary erases the harm caused by the tapering policy. Dr. Adeyemi Fatoki, one of plaintiffs’ experts, explained the harm from tapering at his deposition:

People get anxious. They get, like, rapid heart rate. They have sweating, abdominal pain. They are dysphoric, meaning that their mood may be more like a depressed mood. They have joint pain. They can have dehydration from vomiting and diarrhea.

(Dr. Fatoki Dep. 90:14-19, ECF No. 218-2 at 90.)

These injuries “are sufficiently concrete to confer standing,” *Helbachs Cafe LLC v. City of Madison*, 46 F.4th 525, 529 (7th Cir. 2022). Nothing that subsequently occurred undercuts this “injury in fact.” Moreover, even if a constitutional injury does not cause compensable damages, a plaintiff is entitled to nominal damages because “the law recognizes the importance to organized society that those rights be scrupulously observed.” *Carey v. Phiphus*, 435 U.S. 247, 266 (1978). The Court should therefore reject defendants’ legal theory.

2. The motion to decertify is not supported by the record

In addition to being legally erroneous, defendants do not provide any evidentiary basis for their claim that “many class members in fact *benefited* from the OTP tapering policy.” (ECF No. 218 at 2) (emphasis in original.) Defendants support this contention with a citation to the depositions of

plaintiffs' experts, but neither citation supports the assertion that "many benefited."

The deposition testimony defendants cite compares the relative harms of tapering with abrupt cessation of methadone, as shown in the following question and answer of plaintiff's expert Dr. Fatoki:

Question: ... Is having no methadone versus having a program in place where're tapered off methadone the same?
Dr. Fatoki: No, it's not. I mean, apparently, tapering people off methadone is better for the patient than no methadone.

(ECF No. 218-2 at 129:12-17, cited at ECF No. 218 at 2.)

The deposition questioning of plaintiffs' expert Dr. Mangat similarly compares the relative harms of tapering and abrupt cessation of methadone:

Question: ... Are you aware whether or not the Illinois Department of Corrections provides any MAT?
Dr. Mangat: I'm aware that during this class action the timeframe from the class action lawsuit base did not offer MAT.
Q: So it would have been worse for them if they had not tapered and gone cold turkey in the IDOC?
Dr. Mangat: Yes.

(ECF No. 218-1 at 94:23-95:8, cited at ECF No. 218 at 2.)

Nothing in the deposition testimony of either of plaintiffs' experts suggests that if a person is not tapered at the Jail, that person will be forced to quit "cold turkey" at the penitentiary. Speculation is not a basis for decertifying either subclass.

The claim that some class members “benefited” from mandatory tapering is without merit. The same is true for defendants’ assertion that members of the subclass of post-sentence prisoners (Class 2) may serve time in the penitentiary.

3. Persons serving sentences at the Cook County Jail are not sent to the penitentiary or another county jail

Defendants ask the Court to find that included within the post-sentence prisoners in subclass 2 are persons who, after serving a sentence in the Jail, will be transferred to the IDOC or another county jail. (ECF No. 218 at 3.) This is incorrect based on Illinois law and the class definition.

Under Illinois law, “offenders sentenced to a term of imprisonment for a felony shall be committed to the penitentiary system of the Department of Corrections.” 730 ILCS 5/5-8-6. The post-sentence prisoners at the Jail are serving misdemeanor sentences.²

Illinois law does not permit a person to serve a misdemeanor sentence at the Jail and then be transferred to IDOC to serve a felony sentence. When a defendant is sentenced to a misdemeanor and a felony, “the misdemeanor

sentence shall be merged in and run concurrently with the felony sentence.”

730 ILCS 5/5-8-5.³

It is conceivable that there are sentenced prisoners who leave the Jail to serve a misdemeanor sentence in another county; such persons, however, are excluded from Subclass 2 by the class definition because they were held at the Jail “on a warrant from another jurisdiction.” (ECF No. 178 at 18.)

4. Defendants fail to provide the number of persons they claim were not harmed by tapering

In addition to the factual flaws in defendants’ argument of “no injury,” defendants fail to provide the number of persons they claim are included within the class definition but were not harmed by tapering.

It is only when a class “contains a great many persons who have suffered no injury at the hands of the defendant,” *Kohen v. P. Inv. Mgt. Co. LLC*, 571 F.3d 672, 677 (7th Cir. 2009), that an overinclusive class definition is a barrier to class certification. The “great many persons” standard requires a “high” percentage or a “vast number” of non-class members. *Messner v. Northshore Univ. HealthSystem*, 669 F.3d 802, 824 (7th Cir. 2012). While “[t]here is no precise tipping point at which a class includes too many

³ 730 ILCS. 5/5-8-4 provides: “A defendant serving a sentence for a misdemeanor who is convicted of a felony and sentenced to imprisonment shall be transferred to the Department of Corrections, and the misdemeanor sentence shall be merged in and run concurrently with the felony sentence.”

people who have not been harmed,” *Lacy v. Cook County*, 897 F.3d 847, 864 (7th Cir. 2018), defendants do not present any evidence about the number of “no injury” individuals within either subclass.

Rather than providing the number, if any, of class members they assert must be removed from each subclass, defendants ask the Court to place the case on hold while they continue their attempts to gather this data. (ECF No. 218 at 6 n.9.) The Court should deny this request for an open-ended extension of time: Defendants already secured an extension of time to file their motion (from December 19, 2022 to January 9, 2023) to gather this data. (ECF No. 215, ¶ 2.)

5. The Court should amend the definition of each subclass

Defendants argue in the alternative that the class definitions should be amended. (ECF No. 218 at 13-14.) As shown above, the Court should reject defendants’ “no injury” argument. But, if the Court accepts defendants’ argument that a detainee who was tapered and then transferred to the IDOC cannot be a class member, there is no basis to decertify. In that case, the Court should instead redefine the class to exclude those individuals from the class definition. “If the evidence calls into question the propriety of defining a class in a particular way, then the definition must be modified or subclasses certified.” *Fonder v. Sheriff of Kankakee County*, 823 F.3d 1144, 1147 (7th Cir. 2016).

Defendants also ask the Court to set the ending date of each subclass to an unspecified date in July of 2017. (ECF No. 218 at 13-14.) Plaintiffs show below that this request is not supported by the evidence. A more appropriate modification of the class definition is to amend each subclass to exclude persons who, starting in September of 2017, received methadone at a maintenance dosage and were not tapered.

Defendants have submitted 1,118 pages excerpted from two larger documents (totaling 3,736 pages) of methadone administration records.⁴ (Group Exhibit G, ECF No. 224-1 through 224-8.) Defendants do not provide any analysis of this data, but state the following conclusion:

A review of the OTP dosing history for all class members reveals that approximately 400 patients were provided MAT without tapering for some or all of their time in the CCJ between July 2017 and October 2019 (the end of the class period).

(ECF No. 218 at 14.)

Defendants appear to be asking “the court to search the record to find support” for this argument. *Williams v. Bd. of Educ. of City of Chicago*, 982 F.3d 495, 510 (7th Cir. 2020). The Court should reject this invitation to

⁴ Defendants produced the first document, “Dosing History 1/20/2014-3/31/2019,” on April 26, 2019 (before the Court ruled on class certification). This document consists of 3,057 pages. Defendants produced the second document, “Dosing History 4/1/2019 to 11/7/2019,” on May 11, 2022; it consists of 679 pages.

depart from the “principle of party presentation.” *United States v. Sineneng-Smith*, 140 S. Ct. 1575, 1579 (2020).

The Court should also reject defendants’ assertion that approximately 400 patients listed in defendants’ submission were provided MAT without tapering. (ECF No. 218 at 14.) A review of the first 137 pages of ECF No. 224-1 shows at least 7 class members who were in fact tapered:

- K.B. was tapered from 140 mg to 105 mg between March 12, 2019 and March 24, 2019. (ECF No. 224-1 at 54.)
- W.B. was tapered from 35 mg to 11 mg from December 22, 2017 to January 7, 2018. (ECF No. 224-1 at 68.)
- T.B. was tapered from 30 mg to 3 mg from September 24, 2018 to October 14, 2018. (ECF No. 224-1 at 75.)
- D.B. was tapered from 75 mg to 2 mg from May 17, 2018 to August 27, 2018. (ECF No. 224-1 at 89-90.)
- R.B. was tapered from 45 mg to 1 mg from May 24, 2018 to June 13, 2018. (ECF No. 224-1 at 109.)
- A.B. was tapered from 150 mg to 36 mg from December 9, 2017 to May 4, 2018. (ECF No. 224-1 at 130-134.)
- J.B. was tapered from 135 mg to 80 mg from December 15, 2017 to December 28, 2017. (ECF No. 224-1 at 137.)

Plaintiffs have reviewed the same data from which the defendants claim to have counted records showing that “approximately 400 patients” were not tapered. Plaintiffs are unable to check defendants’ conclusion because defendants do not include their definition of “tapered.”

Plaintiffs have identified 1,114 persons who received more than one dose of methadone at the Cook County Jail after July 1, 2017.⁵ These persons are identified in Exhibit 1, which pursuant to 42 C.F.R. § 2.12(a), must be filed under seal. (Plaintiffs file a redacted version with this memorandum.) Defendants do not offer their own count of the total number of persons who received methadone at the Jail after July 1, 2017.

Of the 1,114 persons plaintiffs identified, 93 of these persons were not tapered, i.e., their final dose of methadone was the same amount as their first dose. Plaintiff identifies these persons in Exhibit 2. Some of the persons who were not tapered were likely pregnant, and therefore excluded from the mandatory tapering policy.⁶ Excluding the 93 person who were not tapered leaves more than 1,000 person who were subject to mandatory tapering after July 1, 2017.

⁵ The 168 persons who received only one dose of methadone are not included in either subclass.

⁶ The tapering policy included an exception for pregnant persons, who would continue to receive their maintenance dosage.

Even accepting defendants' claim that 400 patients were not tapered, that leaves over 600 persons who were tapered pursuant to the challenged policy. That is, a large number of persons were subjected to mandatory tapering at the Jail after July 1, 2017. This shows that defendants continued to apply the policy during the class period.

Plaintiffs agree with defendants that the policy was not applied to all class members after July 1, 2017. Accordingly, plaintiffs do not object to excluding from each subclass persons who were not tapered pursuant to the policy. Plaintiffs therefore propose that the definition of each subclass be amended to exclude persons who were not tapered. The amendment requires the addition of the same phrase to the definition of each subclass:

Class 1 (Pre-trial Detainees) comprises all pre-trial detainees who (1) entered the Cook County Jail between December 23, 2013 and October 7, 2019, inclusive and (2) opted out of, or are otherwise excluded from, participation in *Parish v. Sheriff*, 07-cv-4369; and were, at the time of entry into the Jail, lawfully taking an opioid antagonist, as defined in 42 C.F.R. 8.12(h)(2), who were not then on parole or held on a warrant from another jurisdiction, who were not pregnant, who received more than one dose of methadone while detained, and whose ending dose of methadone was less than their starting dose;

Class 2 (Post-sentence Prisoners) comprises all post-sentencing prisoners who (1) entered the Cook County Jail between December 23, 2013 and October 7, 2019, inclusive and (2) opted out of, or are otherwise excluded from, participation in *Parish v. Sheriff*, 07-cv-4369; and were, at the time of entry into the Jail, lawfully taking an opioid antagonist, as defined in 42 C.F.R. 8.12(h)(2), who were not then on parole or held on a warrant from another jurisdiction, who were not pregnant, who

received more than one dose of methadone while detained, and whose ending dose of methadone was less than their starting dose.

6. Defendants do not otherwise present a coherent challenge to continuing to maintain this case as a class action

In ordering that the case would be maintained as a class action, the Court found that the case satisfied the four requirements (numerosity, commonality, typicality, and adequacy of representation) of Rule 23(a) and that certification of two subclasses was appropriate under Rule 23(b)(3). (ECF No. 178.)

Defendants do not ask the Court to revisit its findings about numerosity and adequacy of representation. Defendants' challenge to commonality and typicality is limited to the legally erroneous and factually unsubstantiated claim that each subclass includes persons who suffered no injury, as discussed above. The same is true for defendants' challenge to the superiority and predominance standards of Rule 23(b)(3).

The general rule is that reconsideration of a class certification order under Rule 23 turns on "subsequent developments in the litigation." *General Telephone Co. v. Falcon*, 457 U.S. 147, 160 (1982). As stated in the 1996 Advisory Committee Notes to Rule 23: "A determination once made can be altered or amended before the decision on the merits if, upon fuller

development of the facts, the original determination appears unsound.” This rule is summarized in an authoritative treatise:

In the absence of materially changed or clarified circumstances, or the occurrence of a condition on which the initial class ruling was expressly contingent, courts should not condone a series of rearguments on the class issues by either the proponent or the opponent of class, in the guise of motions to reconsider the class ruling

Defendants are familiar with this standard. *See, e.g., Parish. v. Sheriff of Cook County*, 07 C 4369, 2016 WL 1270400, at *1 (N.D. Ill. Mar. 31, 2016) (denying motion to decertify); *Bennett v. Dart*, 53 F.4th 419 (7th Cir. 2022) (reversing grant of motion to decertify). Nonetheless, defendants present their motion to decertify without offering “any new evidence or arguments.” *In re Evanston N.W. Corp. Antitrust Litig.*, 07-CV-04446, 2013 WL 6490152, at *3 (N.D. Ill. Dec. 10, 2013). Nor do defendants present developments in the case showing that plaintiffs can no longer demonstrate that the case continues to satisfy Rule 23(a) and Rule 23(b)(3). *In re NorthShore U. HealthSystem Antitrust Litig.*, 07 CV 04446, 2023 WL 2138971, at *4 (N.D. Ill. Feb. 20, 2023). The Court should therefore deny the motion to decertify.

7. Conclusion

The Court should therefore deny defendants’ motion to decertify.
