Under the terms of this certification, you are authorized to use opioid drugs for maintenance and/or detoxification treatment of narcotic addiction at the above referenced location. Please note that methadone, Suboxone®, Subutex®, and FDA-approved generic buprenorphine addiction products are the only narcotic drugs approved for the treatment of narcotic addiction in OTPs. Also, if you relocate your primary dispensing location from the address listed above you, must supplement your certification by submitting form SMA-162 for advanced approval from SAMHSA. Please include the above OTP number in any correspondence concerning your application.
