NOTIFICATION OF DOCKET ENTRY

This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Friday, September 13, 2024:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable Franklin U. Valderrama: The Court has reviewed the parties' joint position statement [412] regarding whether any redactions are needed in the Court's order on the parties' motions to bar the opinions of Michael Brown and Jeffrey Danik [385]. Plaintiffs take the position that no redactions are necessary, but Defendants take the position that the sealed order should be shared with the federal government, and in particular, with AUSA Don Lorenzen, to review the sealed order and advise the parties of the government's position as to redactions. Defendant City of Chicago also requests that it be allowed to share its sealed summary judgment materials with Mr. Lorenzen to determine the government's position on redactions. The Court agrees with Defendants, and directs the parties to provide the Court's order [385], as well as the City's summary judgment materials to Mr. Lorenzen. On or before 10/11/2024, the Government is directed to file a position statement as to whether it believes any redactions are required to the Court's order [385]. The Court extends the deadline for the City to file redacted versions of its summary judgment materials to 10/11/2024, so that it may consult with the government regarding redactions. Mailed notice.
