**AGREED MOTION TO EXTEND TIME
FOR FILING OF REPLY MEMORANDUM**

Plaintiffs, with the agreement of defendants, request the Court to extend for one week (to December 28, 2020) the time in which plaintiffs may file their reply in support of their motion for class certification, ECF No. 129.

Grounds for this motion are as follows:

1. Plaintiffs' reply memorandum is now due on December 21, 2020.
2. On December 8, 2020, the Seventh Circuit announced its decision in *McFields v. Sheriff*, 7th Cir., No. 20-1391, upholding the denial of class certification in a case involving an aspect of dental care at the Cook County Jail.

3. Plaintiffs' counsel also represents the appellants in *McFields* and is preparing a petition for rehearing in that case, due on December 22, 2022.

4. Counsel therefore seeks an additional week to file the reply memorandum on class certification in this case. The additional time is required because of the intervening professional obligation to prepare and file the petition for rehearing in *McFields* and to then include a discussion of *McFields* in the briefing in this case.

5. Defendants do not oppose the requested one-week extension of time.
