NOTIFICATION OF DOCKET ENTRY

This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Monday, October 6, 2025:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable M. David Weisman: Magistrate status hearing held. Discussion held regarding scope of discovery post-remand and substantive issues that remain. Court noted that the docket is not clear as to whether fact discovery or just class discovery is currently at issue. Court noted that when the case was first referred in 2018, class discovery was proceeding initially with merits discovery to follow and no order indicates that approach has changed, and due process concerns indicate that setting a date to complete all merits discovery by 12/15/25 prejudices Plaintiff. Further, Defendant intends to challenge class certification again, making class discovery necessary and relevant to the resolution of this matter. Accordingly, class discovery to close by 12/15/25. Given the age of the case, Court may require the parties to proceed with some fact discovery (i.e., collecting records) while class certification is being pursued. Discussion held regarding issues raised in joint status report. As to Plaintiff DeSavie, interrogatory answers have been received by Defendant and his responses to requests for production due 10/8/25. As to Plaintiff Brown, counsel is having trouble contacting him. Plaintiff Brown to respond to discovery by 10/27/25. As to Plaintiff Abid, parties to determine by 10/20/25 whether he will settle; if not, Plaintiff Abid to respond to discovery by 11/3/25. Regarding transportation logs and grievance spreadsheets, parties to continue discussions; Court noted that time parameters are likely appropriate due to proportionality and burden concerns. Status hearing set for 11/19/25 at 9:15 a.m. Joint status report due by noon on 11/17/25 regarding outstanding topics discussed at this status report. Mailed notice (ao,)
