NOTIFICATION OF DOCKET ENTRY

This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Tuesday, March 5, 2024:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable Nancy L. Maldonado: This case has been selected from among the cases that are part of the Watts Coordinated Proceedings (No. 19-cv-1717) as a test case to be set for trial. The Court understands that Judge Valderrama has set the Baker case (No. 16-cv-8940) as the first Watts trial to begin in January 2025, and last until mid-February; and Judge Seeger has set the Gipson case (No. 18-cv-05120) for trial in late April 2025 through early May 2025. The Court therefore schedules this case for trial beginning on 05/27/2025 at 9:30 a.m. The Court will tentatively reserve 2 weeks for trial. The final pretrial order and motions in limine are due 4/11/2025; responses to motions in limine are due 4/25/2025; no replies are allowed unless directed by the Court. The final pretrial conference is set for 5/8/2025 at 2:00 p.m. The parties are advised to review and comply with the Court's standing order on pretrial procedures. In addition to scheduling this case for trial, by 4/4/2024, the parties shall meet and confer and file a joint status report to include: (1) an update on the status of discovery in the consolidated proceedings, including any existing deadlines for the completion of fact and expert discovery, or, if any cut-off deadlines have yet to be set, proposed deadlines for the completion of fact and expert discovery in this case; (2) proposed briefing schedules for summary judgment and Daubert motions, to be filed no later than 11/22/2024; and (3) any other matters the parties believe should be brought to the Court's attention.
