The following is in essence but not verbatim a summary statement taken of the above named person relative to allegation(s) of misconduct by a Chicago Police Department member.

I, William Carter, went to 540 E. Browning to buy some marijuana. Once I entered the building the people (would not provide the names or personal information) that I buy the weed from were running. I didn't run because I wasn't doing anything and didn't see anybody. I was about to walk up the stairs to the second floor, when I saw the tip of a black gun sticking out from behind the corner of another hallway. I didn't see the person that was holding the gun. I didn't know if the person with the gun was a police officer or a stickup man. When I got to the second floor, I started walking to the other stairway so I could walk down the stairs. As I walked to the other stairway, I turned and saw a male/ black officer (5'5", muscular build, in his 30's, Officer #1) following me with a gun in his hand pointed down to the ground. I started walking faster because I didn't know what was going on. When I got to the stairway, I walked down the stairs to the first floor. Once I was on the first floor, I saw two male/ black officers (5'8", medium build, mid 30's - 5'5", skinny, in his 30's) standing at the entrance. I started walking toward the entrance when another officer (5'5", chubby build, in his early 30's Officer #2) entered the building, pulled out his gun (black, NFI) and pointed it at me. Officer #1 ordered me to lay face down on the ground. I immediately followed the officer's orders and got on the ground.

I was on the ground for about five minutes when Officer #1 came from one of the hallways with 22 bags of heroin and said it was mine. Officer #2 then handcuffed me and placed me in the backseat of a black civilian car (Cavalier or Sunfire). At this time, Officer #2 asked me,
