**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO FILE
REPLY TO CORRECT MIS-CITATION**

Plaintiff, by counsel and without opposition by defendant Wexford, seeks leave to file the following as a reply to the Court's Order to Show Cause of March 18, 2021.

1. Plaintiff included in his response to the Order to Show Cause an extended quotation from the dissenting opinion in *Wells v. Caudill*, 967 F.3d 598 (7th Cir. 2020). (ECF No. 98 at 4.)

2. Plaintiff miscited the quotation as the decision of the Court, rather than from a dissenting opinion.

3. Defendant Wexford correctly points out that a dissenting opinion is not precedential authority. (ECF No. 99 at 3.)

4. Plaintiff apologizes for his error and hereby withdraws any argument that the dissenting opinion in *Wells* is precedential authority.

5. Defendant Wexford does not oppose this motion.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court grant leave to file the foregoing as a reply to the Court's Order to Show Cause of March 18, 2021.
