## ORDER

On consideration of the papers filed in this appeal and review of the district court record,

IT IS ORDERED that this appeal is DISMISSED.

The district court ruled on appellant Glenn Miller's motion to intervene on March 24, 2021, before entry of the final decision in this action. *See Davis v. Advocate Health Center Patient Care Express*, 523 F.3d 681, 683 (7<sup>th</sup> Cir. 2008); *see also Otis v. City of Chicago*, 29 F.3d 1159, 1165-66 (7<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1994) (*en banc*). The next day, March 25, 2021, appellant Glenn Miller filed a notice of appeal – his second. This appeal seeks review of both the order denying intervention and the court's final decision of the case. The earlier appeal filed on February 24, 2021, and docketed as Appeal No. 21-1353, is unnecessary, if not premature because the district court had not issued its ruling on appellant Glenn Miller's motion to intervene at that point.
