AGREED ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter coming before the Court on the Stipulation of the parties, the parties having reached agreement to settle this matter, and the respective parties being represented by counsel, Plaintiff, Vondell Wilbourn, by his attorneys, Law Offices of Kenneth N. Flaxman; Defendant City of Chicago, by its attorney, Mary B. Richardson-Lowry, Corporation Counsel of the City of Chicago; Defendants Philip Cline and Debra Kirby, by their attorneys, Burns Noland LLP, Special Assistant Corporation Counsel; Defendant Ronald Watts, by his attorneys, Johnson & Bell, Ltd., Special Assistant Corporation Counsel; Defendant Kallatt Mohammed, by his attorneys, Mohan Groble Scolaro, P.C., Special Assistant Corporation Counsel; Defendants Brian Bolton, Darryl Edwards, Robert Gonzalez, Alvin Jones, Manuel Leano, Douglas Nichols, Jr., John Rodriguez, Elsworth Smith, Jr., Gerome Summers, Jr., and Kenneth Young, Jr., by their attorneys, Hale & Monico, LLC, Special Assistant Corporation Counsel; and Defendant Calvin Ridgell, Jr., by his attorneys, Borkan & Scahill, Ltd., Special Assistant Corporation Counsel; and the parties have

entered into a Release and Settlement Agreement and Stipulation to Dismiss, the Court being otherwise fully advised in the premises, orders as follows:

All the claims of Plaintiff Vondell Wilbourn against Defendants City of Chicago, Philip Cline, Debra Kirby, Ronald Watts, Kallatt Mohammed, Brian Bolton, Darryl Edwards, Robert Gonzalez, Alvin Jones, Manuel Leano, Douglas Nichols, Jr., Calvin Ridgell, Jr., John Rodriguez, Elsworth Smith, Jr., Gerome Summers, Jr., and Kenneth Young, Jr., including all claims against unknown, unidentified, and/or unserved officers and agents of the Chicago Police Department, are hereby dismissed without prejudice, to be automatically converted to dismissal with prejudice on June 15, 2026, unless a party has moved to extend that date prior to June 15, 2026. Each side shall bear its own costs and attorneys' fees.

All other court-ordered dates and deadlines are vacated.
