This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Friday, December 4, 2020:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable Sheila M. Finnegan: The Court adopts the schedule for discovery and dispositive motions that the parties have proposed in the joint status report dated 11/30/2020, as follows: fact discovery deadline is 5/31/2022; Plaintiffs' expert disclosures due by 6/30/2022, and depositions of those experts to be completed by 8/1/2022; Defendants' expert disclosures due by 9/1/2022, and depositions of those experts to be completed by 10/3/2022; Rebuttal expert disclosures due by 11/3/2022, and depositions of rebuttal experts to be completed by 12/5/2022. By agreement, discovery concerning Individual Defendants' financial condition is to be deferred until after a ruling on summary judgment or, after the deadline for filing such a motion in the event none is filed. Subject to the district judge setting a different schedule, dispositive motions are to be filed by 12/5/2022. As to future lawsuits, if any, that may be filed in the Watts Coordinated Pretrial Proceedings, the parties may seek adjustment of the schedule if necessary.
