IT IS ORDERED that the request to strike the appellees' brief and attached appendix is **GRANTED** to the extent that the appellees' brief, filed on August 12, 2020, is **STRICKEN** and the appellees may refile their brief without the appendix on or before August 27, 2020. Accordingly, **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the motion to withdraw is **DENIED** as unnecessary.
