**NOTIFICATION OF DOCKET ENTRY**

This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Thursday, June 15, 2023:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable Sheila M. Finnegan: Magistrate Judge telephone status hearing held on 6/15/2023 and continued to 7/20/2023 at 11 a.m. in courtroom 2214. The parties are to file an updated joint status report by 7/17/2023. At the Court's request, representatives from non-parties State's Attorney's Office and U.S. Attorney's Office joined the 6/15/2023 hearing to discuss issues related to certain subpoenas. In the next JSR, the parties are to propose schedules for briefing privilege and other issues raised by the non-parties to the discovery that is sought. The parties are also to propose a schedule for expert discovery and the briefing of dispositive motions in the test cases. The Court understands that one of the Plaintiffs' experts will offer opinions based on analysis of the CRs that the City is producing on a rolling basis with substantial completion expected by 7/15/2023. The parties continue to make progress in completing depositions, including those in Waddy v. City of Chicago, 19 L 10035 that recently was set for trial in the Circuit Court of Cook County on 10/16/2023. Due to the need to complete fact and expert discovery, and prepare dispositive motions, within the next 4 months in the Waddy case, Defendants expect to seek an extension of the fact discovery deadline in the test cases (12/18/2023). Plaintiffs intend to oppose this. The Court noted that Judge Valderrama fully expects the Baker/Glenn case (16 C 8940) to proceed to trial in 2024. Mailed notice (sxn)
