AFFIDAVIT OF AVIS ROBERTS

I, Avis Roberts, being first duly sworn and under penalties of perjury, swear and state as follows:

1. On April 1, 2001, I was at home when I heard what sounded like someone trying to break into my apartment door. I opened the door to see what was going on and several men, who I later learned were Chicago Police Officers, pushed their way into my apartment.
2. None of the officers showed me a search warrant.
3. One of the officers pulled me aside and told me that if I didn't sign a consent to search form, that I was going to lose my CHA status and that he was going to make sure I lost my two younger kids. I was scared I would lose everything, so I reluctantly signed the form.
4. That same officer then grabbed my son Joseph and took him downstairs and to the police station.
5. Joseph was charged with possession of cocaine and a gun.
6. To the best of knowledge, Joseph did not have drugs or guns in my house.
