NOTIFICATION OF DOCKET ENTRY

This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Thursday, August 5, 2021:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable Manish S. Shah: The motion to quash [55] is denied. The recently issued subpoena falls within the scope of an earlier, timely subpoena and does not count as "new" discovery prohibited by the court's scheduling order. The narrowed scope of one month around plaintiff's arrest and one month around plaintiff's trial is reasonably likely to contain relevant conversations about plaintiff's damages and the circumstances of his asserted injury (tied to the circumstances of his arrest). The narrowed time frame also does not unnecessarily intrude on plaintiff's privacy. Plaintiff had no expectation of privacy in the recorded calls and even if plaintiff did not expect his calls to be listened to by others, the narrowed time frame exposes only a portion of his communications during the entirety of his detention. The potential probative value outweighs the slight privacy intrusion. The parties' status report remains due 8/17/21. Fact discovery closes 8/31/21. If the parties seek an extension, they should have concrete dates booked for all remaining fact depositions. The court is not inclined to extend discovery without a firm plan to wrap up depositions.
