MINUTE entry before the Honorable Sheila M. Finnegan. Status hearing held on 4/2/2024 and continued to 5/2/2024 at 11:00 a.m. in courtroom 2214. The parties have completed an additional 19 depositions since the filing of the last joint status report (JSR). The parties report the trial in Cook County case Waddy v. City of Chicago, 19 L 10035 has been reset to 7/15/2024, so they will have additional time to complete the remaining depositions in the test cases. For reasons stated on the record and based on its in camera review, the parties' request that the Government provide copies of disks 1D-188 and 1D-189 is denied. By 4/30/2024, the parties are to file another JSR. If they are in agreement that there is no need for a status hearing on 5/2/2024, the JSR should indicate this. Regarding Plaintiffs' motion for default judgment as to Defendant Calvin Ridgell [585], Ridgell's deposition has now been completed. Given this and based on other information learned since the filing of the motion, Plaintiffs are considering whether to withdraw the motion. If they elect not to do so, Plaintiffs' counsel are to discuss with Ridgell's counsel a proposed schedule for filing supplemental briefs and include this in the next JSR. Mailed notice (sxw)
