MINUTE entry before the Honorable Sheila M. Finnegan. Magistrate judge status hearing held on 5/8/2024. Defendants' joint motion for Rule 35 examination of Plaintiff Clarissa Glenn and for a limited extension of expert discovery to disclose a rebuttal expert if the motion is granted [725] is taken under advisement. Plaintiff's response is due 5/22/2024. Defendants' reply is due 5/29/2024. If the Individual Defendant Officers intend to file a supplement in support of their opposition to the Cook County State's Attorney's motion to quash subpoena for depositions of Eric Sussman, Joseph Magats, Mark Rotert, and Nancy Adduci [534], the supplement is to be filed by 5/20/2024. The City's opposed oral motion for a two–week extension of time to respond to Plaintiffs' 4/1/2024 disclosure of the Monell expert, due to the length of that disclosure (112 pgs) and breadth of documents reviewed by the expert, is taken under advisement. Since extending the 5/13/2024 disclosure date to 5/27/2024 would also necessitate extending the 6/3/2024 deadline to depose Defendants' expert as well as the 6/10/2024 deadline for Daubert motions related to the Monell experts, the Court will confer with Judge Valderrama before ruling. The next joint status report is due by 5/30/2024. Mailed notice (sxw)
