**NOTIFICATION OF DOCKET ENTRY**

This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Wednesday, August 7, 2024:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable Sheila M. Finnegan. Magistrate judge status hearing held on 8/7/2024. Defendants' unopposed request for 2-day extension of time until 8/7/2024 to produce disclosures for two of their experts in the Gipson case is granted. All other dates are to remain the same. Regarding depositions of current/former CCSAO attorneys and FBI agents, counsel for the CCSAO and the United States are to confer with counsel for the parties to identify dates for depositions. The Court will be issuing rulings on disputes over deposition topics within 14 days and it is important that these depositions proceed thereafter given the impending trial dates in certain of the test cases. The Individual Defendants report that they plan to file a motion to compel production of the remaining FBI recordings (that the United States has declined to produce) but indicate these recordings will not be the subject of questioning at depositions of the current/former FBI agents. Given this, there is no reason to delay the depositions to await a ruling. Defendants' motion to compel is due 8/16/2024. The United States' response is due 8/30/2024. Reply is due 9/6/2024. The parties are to file a joint status report by 9/18/2024 updating the Court on all outstanding discovery matters. As to FBI recordings produced by the United States (as distinct from recordings that the parties were permitted to listen to but that were not produced to them), counsel for the parties may confer with counsel for the United States about seeking entry of an agreed court order that clarifies whether counsel may now allow their clients to listen to these recordings.
