NOTIFICATION OF DOCKET ENTRY

This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Thursday, August 29, 2024:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable Sheila M. Finnegan. Docket entry 798 is amended as follows: For reasons stated in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion and Order, the Cook County State's Attorney's Office's Motion to Quash Subpoena for the Depositions of Eric Sussman, Joseph Magats, Mark Rotert, and Nancy Adduci [534] is granted in part and denied in part. While the subpoenas will not be quashed so the depositions may proceed, the Court grants in part the CCSAO's alternative request to limit the topics that may be explored on the terms described in this Opinion. In addition, current CCSAO attorney Adduci must be deposed before the other three witnesses who are former CCSAO attorneys. Because the Opinion refers to matters in documents produced under seal, it is currently sealed so the parties, as well as non-party CCSAO, may review it and determine whether there is a need (and legal basis) for potential redactions in the public version of the Opinion. If any party, or non-party CCSAO, seeks to redact any portions of the public version of the Opinion, that party is to file a supporting motion by 9/19/2024 with a specific showing of good cause for confidentiality consistent with Seventh Circuit standards. That motion may be filed under seal. After a ruling on the motion, the Court will issue a public version of the Order. Mailed notice (sxw)
