PLAINTIFFS' UNOPPOSED MOTION TO FILE DOCUMENTS UNDER SEAL

Plaintiffs, by counsel and without opposition from defendants, respectfully seek leave of Court to file their response to Defendant City of Chicago's Rule 56.1 Statement and six exhibits under seal. Grounds for this motion are as follows:

1. Defendant City of Chicago was granted leave to file its Rule 56.1 Statement (ECF No. 122) under seal because the filing contained material produced pursuant to confidentiality orders. (ECF No. 126.)
2. The Court should grant plaintiffs leave to file their response to the Rule 56.1 Statement under seal because the response contains the same confidential material.
