MINUTE entry before the Honorable Jeffrey T. Gilbert: The Court has reviewed the parties' Joint Updated Status Report on Discovery [114]. The parties shall file by 2/3/21 a joint notice of confirmed dates for the depositions of Defendants Kinsey and Gregoire-Watkins to take place before 2/26/21. On or before 3/2/21, the parties shall file a joint notice of confirmed dates for the other depositions that still need to be taken per their Joint Updated Report [114].
