MINUTE entry before the Honorable Jeffrey T. Gilbert: Plaintiff's Motion to Compel [54] is granted. Defendants shall produce the transcripts of Plaintiff's criminal trial that Plaintiff is requesting in his Motion [54] and that Plaintiff requested in his previously served Request for Production of Documents No. 5 [60–1]. If Defendants have the transcripts in electronic form, then they shall produce them to Plaintiff in that form, and Plaintiff shall pay any reasonable cost incurred by Defendants in producing the documents in this way. If Defendants have the transcripts only in hard copy, then Defendants shall produce to Plaintiff copies of those transcripts at Plaintiff's expense. If the documents are to be made available to Plaintiff for inspection and copying in accordance with Fed.R.Civ.Pro. 34, then Defendants shall make them so available at a reasonable time and place. If Plaintiff does not want to physically inspect or copy the transcripts during the COVID–19 pandemic, then he can choose to have all the transcripts produced to him in accordance with this order either electronically or in hard copy at his expense. The Court has read the parties' briefs on the issues presented in Plaintiff's Motion [54] and believes Plaintiff has the better part of this argument as it relates to the transcripts of Plaintiff's state court criminal proceeding. The hearing set for 10/14/20 [57] on Plaintiff's Motion [54] is stricken in light of this order. Mailed notice(ber,)
