DOCKETING STATMENT

Plaintiff Anthony Murdock invoked the jurisdiction of the district court under 28 U.S.C. § 1343 to assert claims arising under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 against defendant City of Chicago.

Duwayne Richardson, Andrew Cruz, Theresa Kennedy, John Perry, Myron Nelson, Chawan Lowe, Johonest Fischer, Brian Neals, Maurice Grant, and James McGee joined as plaintiffs in an amended complaint filed on April 27, 2021. Plaintiffs Grant, Nelson, and Richardson were “dismissed without prejudice to their seeking to participate in the case as absent members of a class” on December 6, 2021. Plaintiffs Lowe, McGee, and Perry were dismissed on the same terms on February 11, 2022.

Plaintiffs Murdock, Cruz, Fischer, and Neals were dismissed on the granting of a motion for judgment on the pleadings on December 1, 2022.

Santiago Bravo and John Plummer joined as plaintiffs in an amended complaint filed on August 16, 2023. Bravo was dismissed on the granting of a motion to dismiss on April 29, 2024.

The remaining plaintiffs, Kennedy and Plummer, were dismissed on the grant of a motion for judgment on the pleadings dated November 6, 2024. This was a final order, resolving all claims of all parties.

Plaintiffs file their notice of appeal on December 2, 2024 and invokes the jurisdiction of the Court of Appeals pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1291.
