Motion hearing held. Defendants' motion for entry of confidentiality order [30] is granted in part and denied in part. As to the disputed issues, the court agrees with Defendants on Paragraphs 6 and 4, and with Plaintiff on Paragraphs 2 and 3. Defendant shall submit a proposed order that reflects these decisions.
