**ORDER APPOINTING INTERIM CO-LEAD CLASS COUNSEL**

WHEREAS, plaintiffs Anthony Dale, Brett Jackson, Johnna Fox, Benjamin Borrowman, Ann Lambert, Robert Anderson, and Chad Hohenbery (“plaintiffs”) filed a complaint in the above-captioned action for alleged violations of Section Seven of the Clayton Act and Section One of the Sherman Act by Deutsche Telekom AG, T-Mobile US, Inc., and SoftBank Group Corp.;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COURT ORDERS:**

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(g)(3), the Court appoints Lieff Cabraser Heimann & Bernstein, LLP, Berger Montague PC, and Hausfeld LLP as Interim Co-Lead Class Counsel and Joel A. Flaxman as Interim Liaison Counsel on behalf of all plaintiffs and the proposed class in this action. The Court finds that the criteria for appointment of Interim Co-Lead Class Counsel under Rule 23(g)(3) are satisfied. Counsel will fairly and adequately represent the interests of the proposed class; performed significant work to identify and

investigate potential claims; have significant experience handling class action litigation, including complex antitrust cases; have knowledge of the applicable law; and will commit sufficient resources to represent the proposed class.
