Dear Counsel:

We represent Altice USA, Inc. (“Altice”) in connection with discovery in *Dale v. Deutsche Telekom AG*, Case No. 1:22-cv-03189 (N.D. Ill.). We understand that Plaintiffs in that case have issued a subpoena to Defendant T-Mobile US, Inc. (“T-Mobile”) which implicates documents Altice produced to T-Mobile in connection with *State of New York v. Deutsche Telekom AG*, Case No. 19-cv-05434 (S.D.N.Y.) (“State AG Case”).

We will not object to T-Mobile’s production of those Altice documents provided that Altice be treated as the “Producing Party” under the Court’s March 23, 2023 Protective Order for any documents bearing an Altice Bates number. We also ask that any Altice documents marked “HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL” or “CONFIDENTIAL” be treated as though they had been marked according to the Protective Order’s designations, “HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL – SUBJECT TO PROTECTIVE ORDER” and “CONFIDENTIAL – SUBJECT TO PROTECTIVE ORDER” respectively.
