The appropriate proposed order must be sent in both Word and PDF formats. Defense counsel Perrone reported that he will be filing a motion to withdraw in light of new employment. The Court ordered counsel's motion to withdraw to be filed by 5/16/23. In light of new defense counsel taking over this case, the Court entered and continued the joint motion to extend fact discovery [19] until 6/1/23. Status/Motion hearing scheduled for 6/1/23 at 1:00 p.m. The Court will work with the parties to set out an appropriate discovery schedule at the 6/1/23 hearing. Plaintiff's counsel must consult with the new defense attorney assigned to the case and file a status report by noon on 5/30/23, addressing: the status of written discovery (including whether defendants have supplemented their written discovery responses, and if not, an anticipated timeframe for doing so); a listing of depositions that the parties intend to take; an estimated timeframe for completing all depositions; and any other issues the parties wish to raise with the Court.
