MINUTE entry before the Honorable Sunil R. Harjani: For the reasons stated in the Memorandum Opinion and Order entered this day, Defendants' motion to dismiss [111] is granted in part and denied in part. Counts I, IV, V, VI, and VII are dismissed without prejudice. Counts II and III survive. Plaintiffs may refile an amended complaint if they can cure the deficiencies and such an amendment is consistent with their obligations under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 11. Given the time associated with repleading and likely subsequent motion practice, Plaintiffs should give consideration as to whether they can really cure the deficiencies identified as a result of the Court's reasoning and decision in this matter. Any amended complaint is due by August 21, 2024. If Plaintiffs do not file an amended complaint by that date, then the dismissal will automatically convert to a dismissal with prejudice on those dismissed counts, and Defendants' answer is due by September 11, 2024 as to Counts II and III.
