NOTIFICATION OF DOCKET ENTRY

This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Tuesday, April 1, 2025:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable Laura K. McNally. The Court has reviewed the parties' joint status report [225], which is largely focused on disagreements over various defendants' collections and productions of documents. Plaintiffs report that they intend to move to compel in the near future. The status report indicates that the parties have met and conferred, but Abbott disputes whether they are truly at impasse, noting "Abbott did not hear back from Plaintiffs on their proposal." The Individual Defendants describe a conferral process that appears to be proceeding in writing. The Court reminds the parties of the requirements of Local Rule 37.2. Given the present stay of testimonial discovery, the parties should make sure they have taken the time to fully explore their opponents' respective positions (by phone, video, or in person) before declaring an impasse. If a motion to compel is filed, the Court will set a briefing schedule. The parties are directed to file another joint status report 5/30/25. Mailed notice (sxn)
