AMENDED MINUTE entry before the Honorable Young B. Kim: Status hearing held by phone and continued to May 1, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. by phone. Parties are to use the same call-in information. Based on the discussion held today, the court overrules the City's objections over Plaintiffs' plan to seek what they consider to be "Rule 404(b)" discovery. This court is satisfied that the proposed discovery is relevant to the Monell claims. Plaintiffs Mendoza and Mulero are ordered to serve Defendant City of Chicago (copy to others) by April 18, 2025, with the following: (1) Rule 26(a)(1) disclosures on their Monell claims against the City; (2) Interrogatories and Requests for Documents; and (3) Rule 30(b)(6) deposition notice. At the next status hearing, the parties are to be prepared to discuss: (4) how Plaintiffs and the City would like to resolve any discovery objections to Plaintiffs' Monell discovery requests; and (5) whether expert discovery as it pertains to Plaintiffs' claims against Individual Defendants should proceed while Monell discovery moves forward.
