MINUTE entry before the Honorable Rebecca R. Pallmeyer: In–person pre–trial conference held. The parties participated in a settlement conference with the court and will notify the court by 4:00 Central time on 10/21/2024 whether they have reached an agreement or expect to do so. For the reasons stated on the record, Plaintiff's Motions in Limine [27] are granted as follows: (1) Evidence of Mr. Anderson's convictions will be limited to the sanitized information concerning the fact of his incarceration and date of release. Defendant will not argue or offer evidence concerning his ability or inability to pay damages. Defendant does not expect to offer prejudicial evidence or arguments identified in motions 3 and 4. Without objection, motions in limine 1, 2, 3 (pertaining to other disciplinary actions) and 4 are granted. (2) Regarding proposed exhibits to which objections have been asserted: statements in the incident report or disciplinary report that were made by defendant are admissible as the statements of a party opponent. Statements in Plaintiff's complaint are admissible for impeachment purposes; the only grievances admissible in this case would be those directly relating to the incident giving rise to this lawsuit.
