This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Friday, February 2, 2024:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable John F. Kness: On 12/28/2023, the Court instructed the parties to file a Status Report no later than 10 days before the 02/05/2024 status hearing [8]. The parties did not file a joint status report, nor did Plaintiff file a report on its own. Instead, on 02/02/2024, Plaintiff filed a second motion to postpone the initial status hearing [10]. Plaintiff explained in the motion that this case is part of a group of cases coordinated for pretrial proceedings. Of that group, a handful of cases were selected as "test" cases, and this case is not one of the "test" cases. As a result, discovery is stayed, and Plaintiff continues to wait for Defendant's authorization to waive service and appear. Accordingly, Plaintiff's motion [10] is granted.
