NOTIFICATION OF DOCKET ENTRY

This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Thursday, October 10, 2024:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable Sheila M. Finnegan. Magistrate Judge video status hearing held on 10/10/2024. The Court reviewed issues described in the JSR dated 9/26/2024. Defendant Rubinstein reports that the CCSAO produced some notes from Felony Review file but not all that he seeks, and the CCSAO will be asked to state in writing that no other documents could be located. Defendants are to promptly confer with Plaintiff Tinajero's counsel about health care providers and issue any subpoenas for medical and/or mental health records within 7 days. To the extent any party has not yet issued planned document subpoenas, they are to issue them within 30 days unless there is a reason the subpoenas cannot issue yet (e.g., awaiting IDOC call logs). The discovery deadline is extended to 3/31/2025 for reasons stated on the record. Counsel for Plaintiffs Martinez and Kelly and counsel for Defendants Rubinstein and Cook County report that they have reached a settlement in principle and expect the written agreement to be executed very soon. Plaintiff's Tinajero's motion to order settlement conference [94] is denied for reasons stated on the record. However, the Court urges Cook County's settlement counsel to begin settlement talks with Tinajero's counsel, and will ask for an update at the next status hearing. Participants are directed to keep their device muted when they are not speaking. Audio recording of the hearing is not permitted; violations of this prohibition may result in sanctions.
