JOINT INITIAL STATUS REPORT

The parties submit the following joint status report:

1. Descriptions of Claims and Relief Sought

A. Nature of the claims

Plaintiff, a detainee at the Cook County Jail, brings claims under Section 202 of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42 U.S.C. § 12132, and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, 29 U.S.C. § 794(a). Plaintiff contends that he is disabled, has been denied accommodations required for him to use toilet and shower facilities and thereby incurred personal injuries. Defendants assert a lack of knowledge about whether plaintiff is disabled and about whether he required accommodations to use toilet and shower facilities and deny that plaintiff has suffered personal injuries.

B. Relief Sought

Plaintiff did not incur any medical expenses. Nor did he lose wages. His compensatory damages are for pain and suffering which plaintiff estimates will total less than \$100,000.

2. Scope of Referral

The case has been referred (ECF No. 14) “for the purpose of holding proceedings related to: discovery supervision and scheduling, to set a deadline to file any motions for leave to amend the pleadings, to set a dispositive motions schedule, and for settlement.”

3. Proposed Discovery Schedule

The parties proposed the following:

- a. Initial disclosures due by 7/15/24
- b. Written discovery completed by 9/13/24
- c. Discovery Close on 10/28/24
- d. Dispositive Motion due by 11/18/24.

The parties do not contemplate expert discovery.

4. Settlement

The parties are not yet able to discuss the possibility of settlement but will revisit this issue at the close of discovery, before filing any dispositive motions.

5. Magistrate Judge Consent

The parties do not unanimously consent.

6. Pending Motions
